## NOTICE TO POSTMASTER AND LAW ENFORCEMENT

I certify that all information furnished in this letter and the supporting documents are accurate, truthful, and complete. I understand that anyone who furnishes false or misleading information relating to this certification may be subject to criminal and/or civil penalties, including fines and imprisonment.

What is contained in this package might look like marijuana, but it is actually legal industrial hemp flower. The 2018 US Farm Bill amended Sec. 297A of the Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946 which re-defined hemp and its legal status this bill also amended sections 102(16) and 202 (c) of the Controlled Substances Act to establish hemp as a separate from marijuana and to establish that THC found in hemp is exempt from the Controlled Substances Act. Below are the amended Acts that make the sale of this hemp product legal:

**Sec. 297A of the Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946 - The term "hemp" means the plant Cannabis Sativa L. And any part of that plant, including the seed thereof and all derivatives, ex-tracts, cannabinoids, isomers, acids, salts, and salts of isomers, whether growing or not, with a delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol concentration of not more than 0.3 percent on a dry weight basis."**

**Section 102(16) of the Controlled Substances Act - "The term "marijuana" does not include hemp, as defined in section 297A of the Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946.."**

**Section 202(c) of the Controlled Substances Act is a table that previously had tetrahydrocannabinol listed as number 17 on the list of Schedule I substances. This entry has been amended and now reads: "(17) Tetrahydrocannabinol, except for tetrahydrocannabinol, except for tetrahydrocannabinol in hemp (as defined under section 297A of the Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946.)"**

The Delta-9 is in such low concentrations in our hemp that it is considered LOQ or "limit of quantification" meaning it is less than 0.1% - well below the 0.3% maximum level. The Oregon Department of Agriculture has licensed this product as "Industrial Hemp" under the allowable provisions set forth by the 2014 US where it is grown Farm Bill which included the pilot program for industrial hemp that lead to the 2018 US Farm Bill with the same standards. Therefore, this hemp flower is legal to possess by anyone in the United States and to sell when done so by a licensed handler. Any hemp possessed by us in the future will comply with all federal and state licensing laws so we can continue to provide high quality hemp to those who need it most.
